## How is this qualification assessed?

Understanding of the course material is evaluated by means of a written assessment paper consisting of Part A and B through 20 multi-format questions and a risk assessment.

## Certification

An IOSH Working safely certificate is awarded to all those who attend the course and successfully complete both the written and practical assessments.

You will receive your results within 10 working days of sitting the assessments. Once you have achieved a pass a qualification certificate will be issued by IOSH. This is normally within 20 working days of the confirmation of successfully passing.
